OF THE EMIGRANT SHIP *MARION* WHICH DEPARTED PLYMOUTH, ENGLAND, ON MONDAY 24TH MARCH 1851 WITH 350 EMIGRANTS ON BOARD – ALL BOUND FOR SOUTH AUSTRALIA

ON TUESDAY 29TH JULY 1851 AT ABOUT 10.00 PM THE 'MARION' STRUCK THE OUTER EDGE OF TROUBRIDGE SHOAL AND ALTHOUGH THE SHIP WAS SUBSEQUENTLY WRECKED, ALL PASSENGERS AND CREW MADE IT ASHORE SAFELY.
