South Brighton is one of the first in Australia to have a **National Men's Health Ambassador Speaker** who is available to speak to community, corporate, business, industrial, military, sporting, educational institutions and men's and women's groups about **Men's Health**. Funded by the Australian Government Department of Health and Ageing, the National Men's Health Ambassador Speaker Program aims to increase awareness about prostate health and men's continence health and also share important links to major national men's health organisations.

Andrew Giles CEO Prostate Cancer Foundation, the national peak organisation for Prostate Cancer said: *"Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia is proud to have initiated the National Men's Health Ambassador Speaker Program funded by the Australian Government Department of Health and Ageing. Men are interested in their health and appreciate opportunities to become more aware of important areas in men's health. Prostate Cancer is diagnosed in 18,700 Australian men every year and sadly 2,700 Australian men lose their life to Prostate Cancer annually. For men in rural Australia, the risk is even higher. For every 100 men who die of Prostate Cancer in a metropolitan area of Australia, 121 men will die in rural Australia. We need to create awareness together"*.
