As the number of batteries I test increase, so does the mess in the test lab. The Doc has been looking for some battery cases for some time. He has 3 from Powerex (Maha Energy), but they cost US\$2 each, plus postage from the US! The Maha cases are very good, as they can store both AA and AAA batteries, 4 of each. Finally, The Doc has sourced some cases from Australia. The cases look like this (a nice large picture for all those readers with poor vision). Look there are the 4 Sanyo 2300 mAh batteries I am currently testing in the case! Oooops better get back to the job at hand.



CONCLUSION

The bad news first. The case can store both AA and AAA batteries, but the AAAs move around in the case (unlike the Powerex case).. The good news is that the AAs fit perfectly and the cases are available online for \$2.50 (Aussie) each or 6 for \$12.50, that is 6 for the price 5 if you were wondering. So protect your batteries from shorting or otherwise

being damaged and buy a few cases. The only source The Doc knows where to purchase the cases is The Battery Wizard: www.thebatterywizard.com Highly recommended (now all the batteries are tidy in the test lab).
