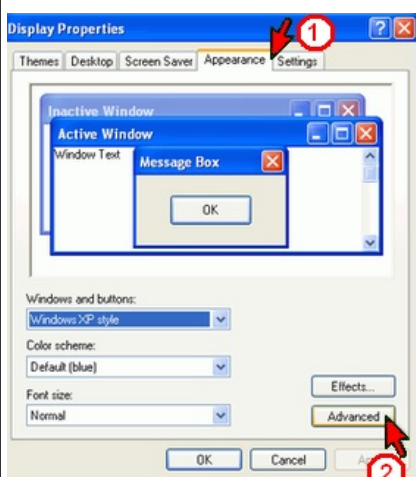
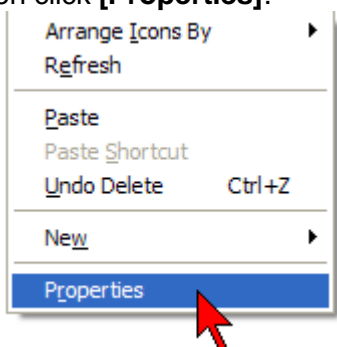
Adjust vertical space between desktop icons

If you add shortcuts to your desktop to launch programs or to open folders, your desktop could quickly become filled with icons. If you'd like more icons to fit on your desktop, you can adjust the spacing between them so that they sit closer together.

To adjust the vertical space between icons.

Right-click the desktop, and then click **[Properties]**.



In the Display Properties dialog box, click the **[Appearance]** tab. Then, click **[Advanced]**.



Click the Item list, and then click **[Icon Spacing(Vertical)]**



In the Size box, decrease the number to move icons closer together, or increase the number to add space between icons.

Click **[OK]**

Tip: Take a note of setting before changing so you can return to default setting.

To change the spacing for your existing desktop icons to the spacing you specified. Right-click your **[Desktop]**, click **[Arrange Icons]** on the shortcut menu, and then click **[Align to Grid]** then finally **[Auto Arrange]**.
