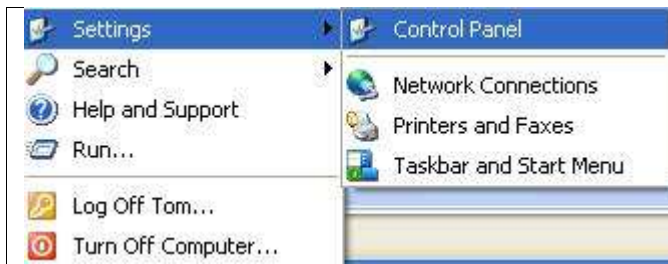
Question on Software or Operating system.

Some users had trouble finding the Arrow Cursor especially when working on a graphic screen. The question is *'How can I make the Arrow Cursor clearer'* ?

Windows 9x, NT, 2000 and XP provided an option of cursors so the user can personalize their computer.

To navigate to these options first left click the  **<start>** button then select

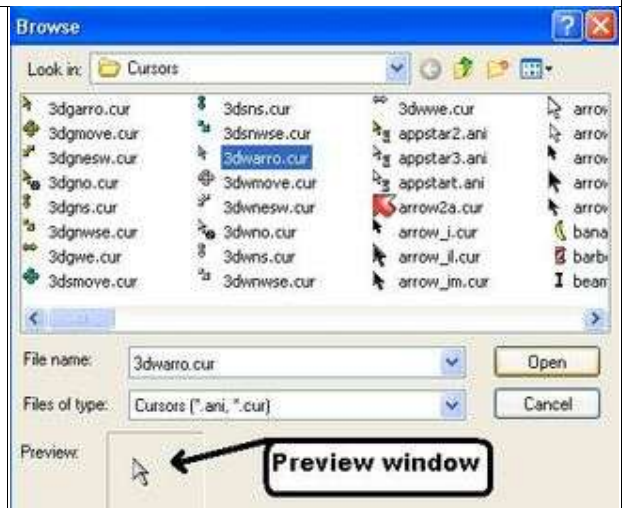
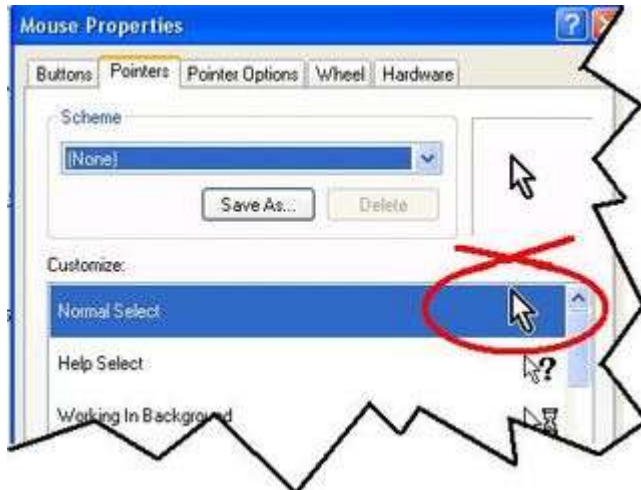
**<Settings>** **<Control Panel>** click on **Control Panel** to open Windows Explorers Control Panel.



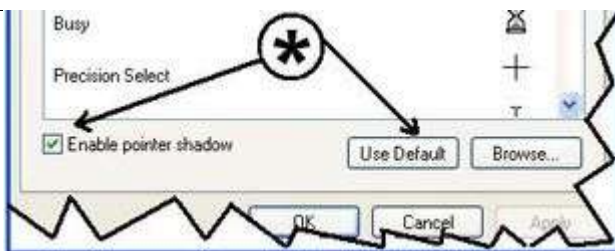
Click on the **Mouse** icon to open the Mouse and Pointers dialog box.



Click the **Pointers** Tab as shown below. **Double Click the Normal Select Arrow Icon** as shown.



Choose your new Arrow Cursor from the large selection. Clicking on one and the chosen cursor is displayed in a preview window. After selecting your new cursor click on **Open** and back out of the options and close down the Control Panel.



Also note the option in the lower left hand corner, **<Enable pointer shadow>** click this box to add a shadow to your cursor.

To return the arrow cursor back to normal click the **[Use Default]** button.
