## What is the Window Key for?



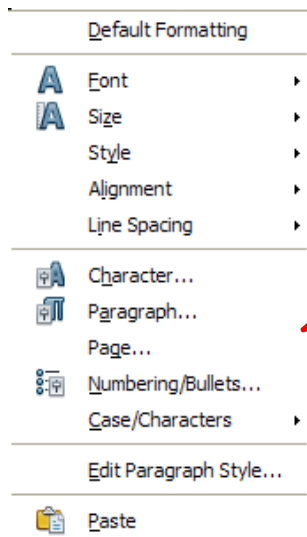
On either side of the spacebar, outside the Alt keys, are two keys with the Windows logo. Holding one Windows key down and pressing another key will activate quite a few actions. Some of the more common are listed in the table below:

Pressing the Window key Displays the Start Menu.	+  Minimizes all windows and shows the Desktop.	+  Opens a new Explorer Window.
+  Displays the Find all files dialog box.	+  Minimizes all open windows.	+  Displays the Run command.
+  Displays the Windows Help menu	+  Displays the Systems Properties dialog box.	+  Cycle through the buttons on the Task Bar.

### The other special key...



The Application key has an image of a mouse pointer on a menu (between the Alt and Ctrl keys to the right of your Space Bar). Depressing this key will display the selected item's shortcut window. This is the menu that is displayed by right-clicking the mouse button.
