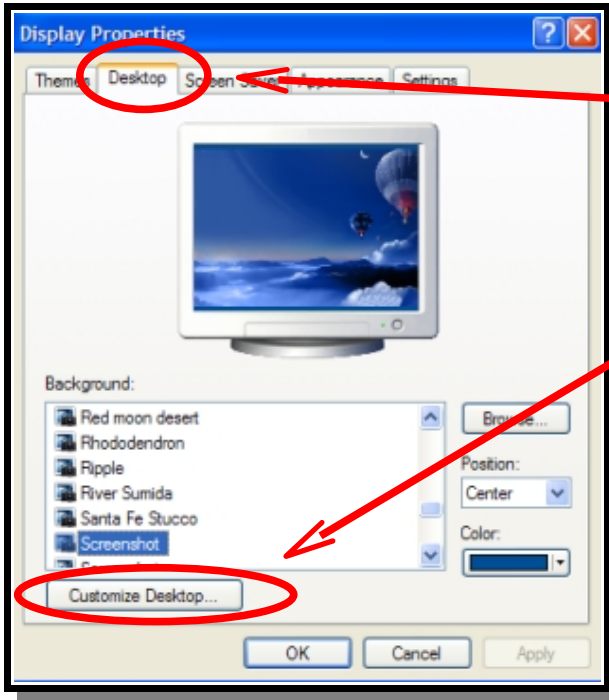
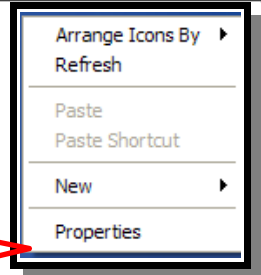
LOST RECYCLE BIN.

Has your Recycle Bin icon ever disappeared from your desktop?

How or why it disappeared is hard to say.

There are couple of ways to recover your lost Recycle Bin in Windows XP.

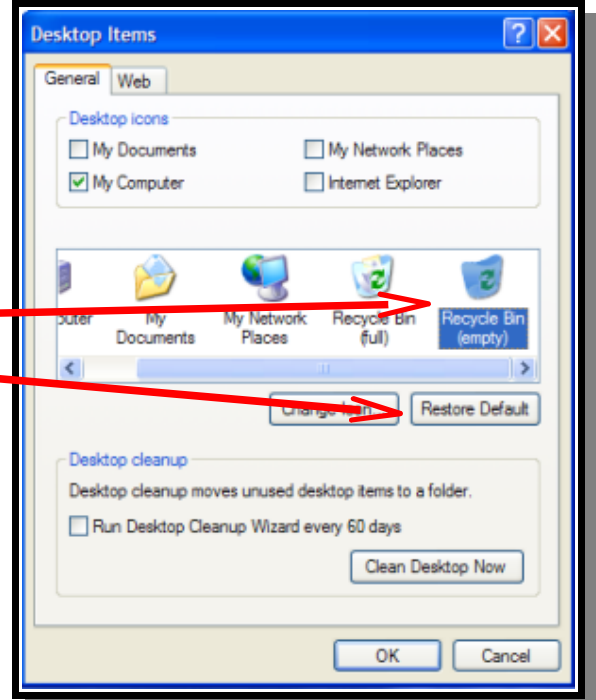
The first thing you can do is right click on your desktop and choose **Properties**.



With the Display Properties box open click on the Desktop tab.

Choose Customize Desktop, click to open the options.

In the middle of that box, you will see some of the more common desktop icons. Click on the one for the Recycle Bin and then hit the Restore Default button. Click OK your Recycle Bin should be on your desktop.



The other way is to download and install **Tweak UI**, one of the "Power Toys" available from Microsoft. Run that, and the **Desktop** section allows you to select which icons to show on the desktop by default. You should be able to turn the recycle bin back on there.
