



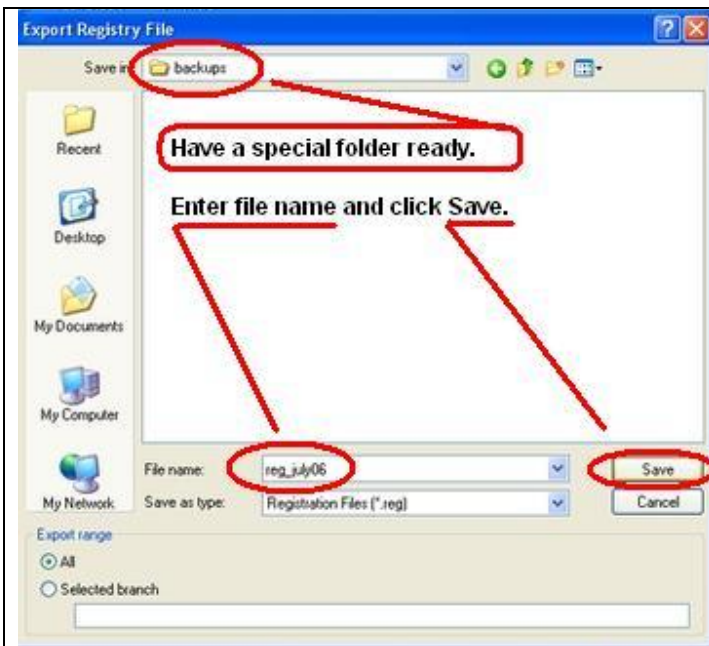
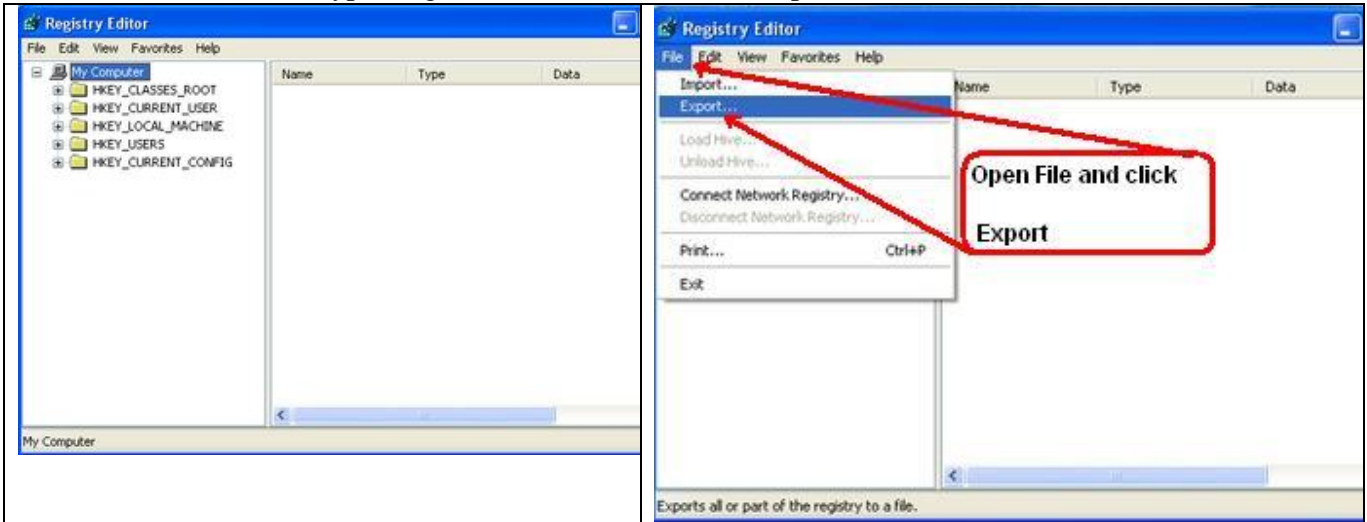

Make a Back-Up of your XP Registry

The registry back-up was important with Windows 95 and 98. Windows XP has a special feature where you can **Restore** the system to an earlier date. So backing up the registry is not that important. You can still back-up the registry to a folder, then burn on to a CD for safe keeping.

1. Close any programs running.
2. Go to [Start].
3. Go to [Run] and type `regedit` and hit OK. This will open the folder below.



Have a special folder ready to store the registry information.

Give the file a name that is easy recognizable.
Example: `regbackupJuly06`.

Once saved, burn on to a CD for safe keeping.
You can then delete the folder.

`reg_july06`

`reg 71.540,6`

The registry files can be quite large as shown above.

Now that you have the registry backed-up its easy to restore.

Go to [Run] and type `regedit` and hit OK. This will open the registry folder.

Go to [File] and select [Import], choose the folder or device that holds your registry file, click OK.

This will restore your registry back to the saved default.
