

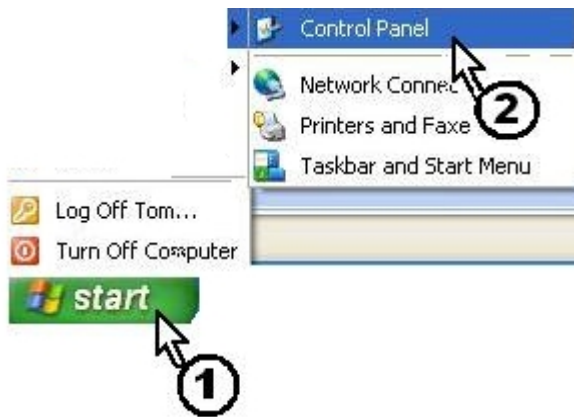


Coffee Break

Using the steps shown on the left

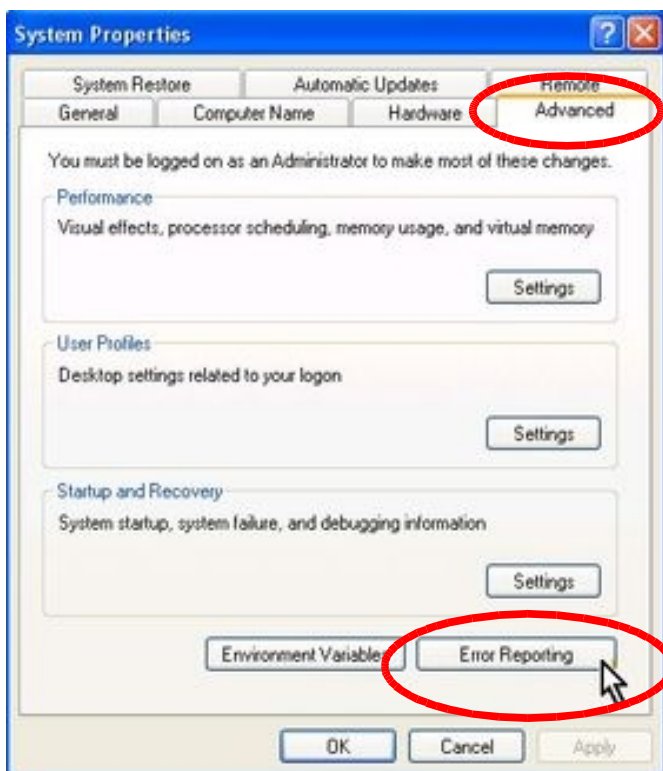
[start] [Control Panel]
