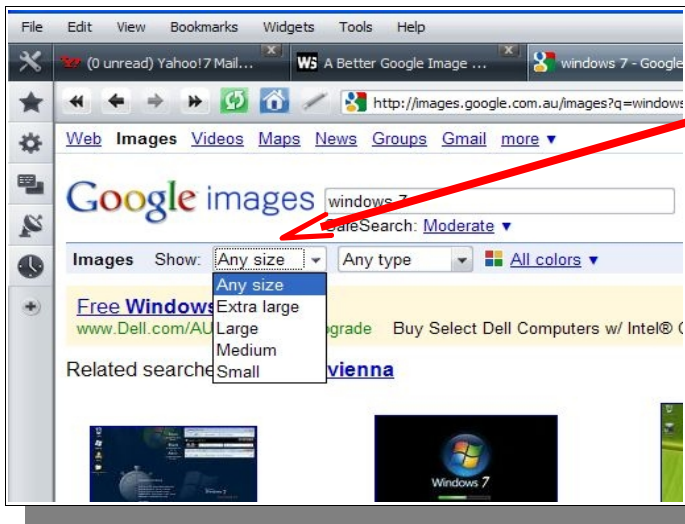

USING GOOGLE IMAGE SEARCH.

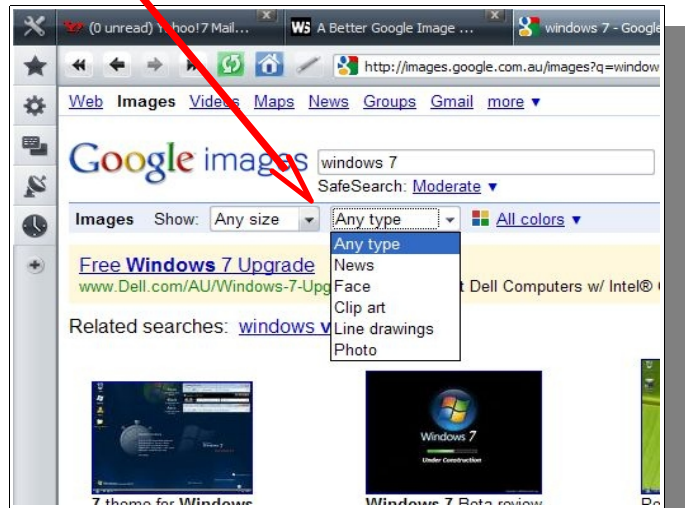
When using Google's Search site you can specify to show images. This can be helpful if you are searching a certain subject, like, Flowers or Roses, a type of Car, paintings or people. There are over a one billion images floating around on the Web, finding the picture you need for your research can be pretty tricky. Google Images helps you manage this difficult feat.



The first step is to open 'Google' and type your search.
The example here is "Windows 7" (Microsoft operating system).
When you have the the results click on [Images]



In the 'Image' search you have a few options. You can choose the size of the images to search.
Also the 'Type'. This can be, **Any Type, News, Faces, Clip Art, Line Drawings & Photos.**



You can choose 'Colors'.
Click the down arrow then click the colour box for your colour search.
If the green was chosen all Windows 7 screen with the colour green would show.

The final option, select the type of images to be shown. Click the [SafeSearch].
