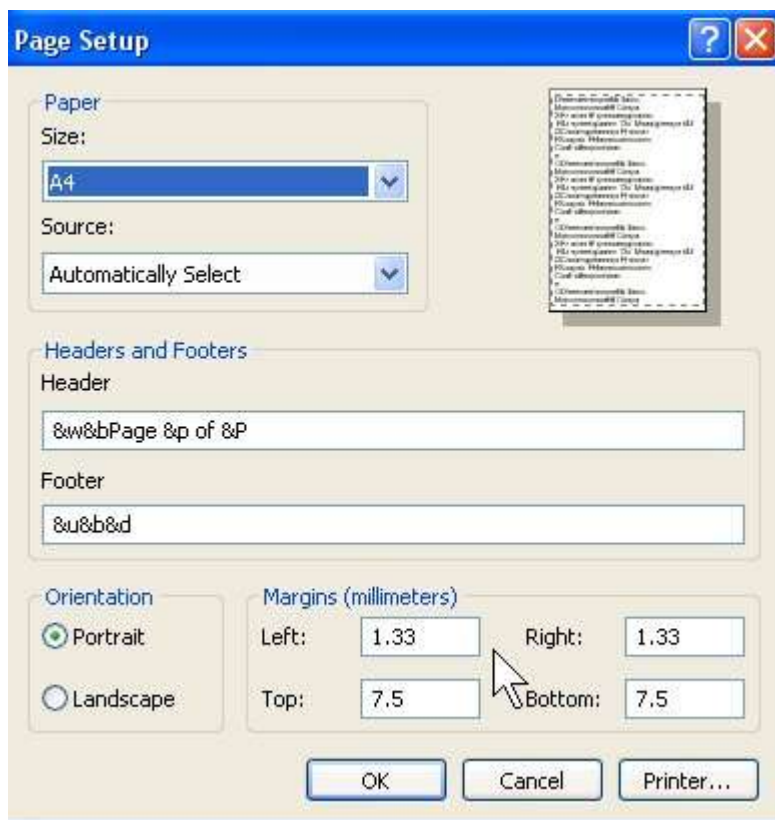
## Windows Internet Explorer print page settings.

Your Windows Internet Explorer web browser print page settings are set by default with left and right margins of 7.5 millimeter. When you printout a web page sometimes the right margin will be too wide for A4 paper used on most home printers. The result is that about 3 characters of the word to the right are lost, making the printout hard to read.

Change your settings in Internet Explorer.



Open Internet Explorer and open **File** pull down menu.  
Left click **Page Setup**.



In the Page Setup Option Menu change the Margins (millimeters) settings to ....

Left: 1.33 millimetre  
Right: 1.33 millimetre

Hi-light the numbers using the mouse.  
The same as a word processor and type in the new settings.

Click OK to close.
