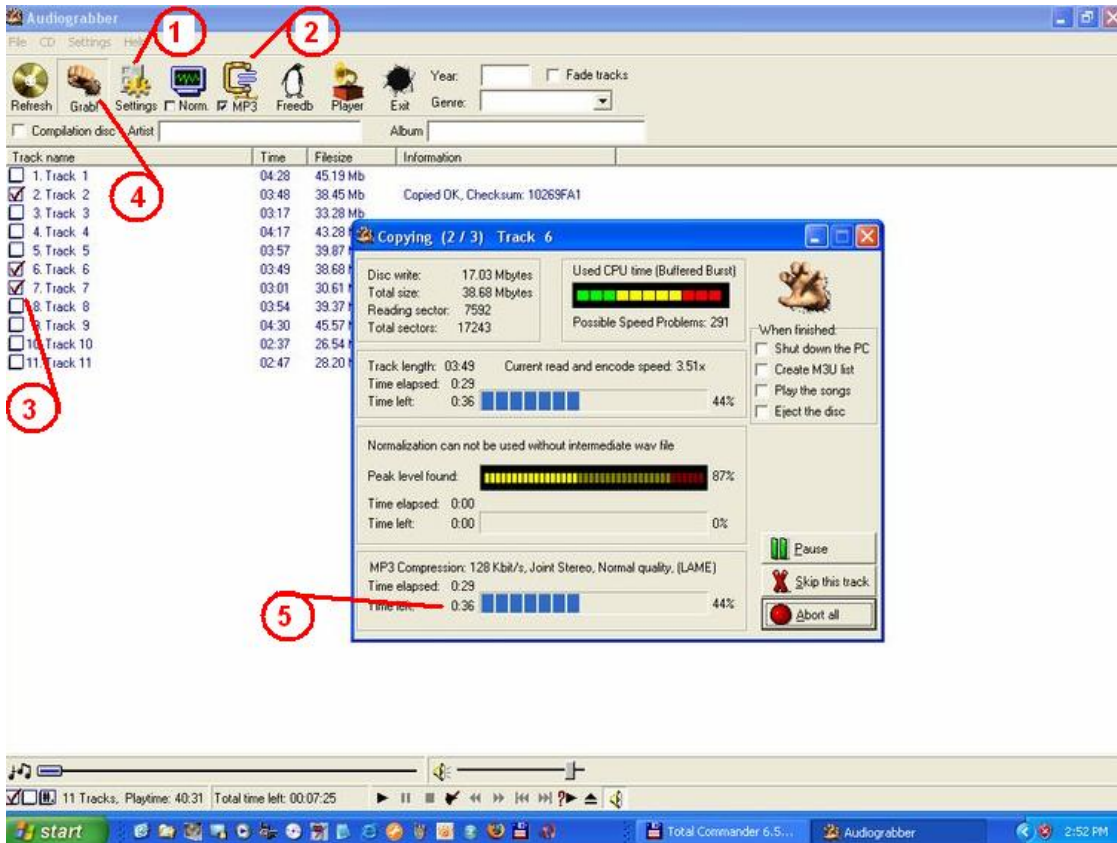

Capture Music files from a CD and convert to MPG-3 for your Mpeg player.

To capture music from your favourite CD to play on your portable Mpeg player requires converting the tracks to a compressed format. The most popular is MP3. Ripping the tracks on your music CDs into MP3 files is easy using this tutorial to guide you through the process. You will need a program from the internet, **Audiograbber** (freeware).

Install and run **Audiograbber**.



Selecting folder to save files.
Example: 'My Music'.

1. Click on setting to choose the folder to save your music file.
2. Place a tick in MP3 check box.
3. Insert your CD and un-tick the tracks you don't want to save.
4. Left click the grab icon.
5. Your music is now been converted to MP3 and saved to you selected folder.
