## **Pho Bac**

Coorong Angus Beef and noodle soup

## **Goi Ga**

Spicy free range chicken, cabbage and peanut salad

## **Suon Heo Rim**

Stir fried caramelised free range Berkshire pork served with rice noodle and fresh Asian herb salad

## **Gao nep**

Black 'forbidden' sticky rice with coconut cream and mango
