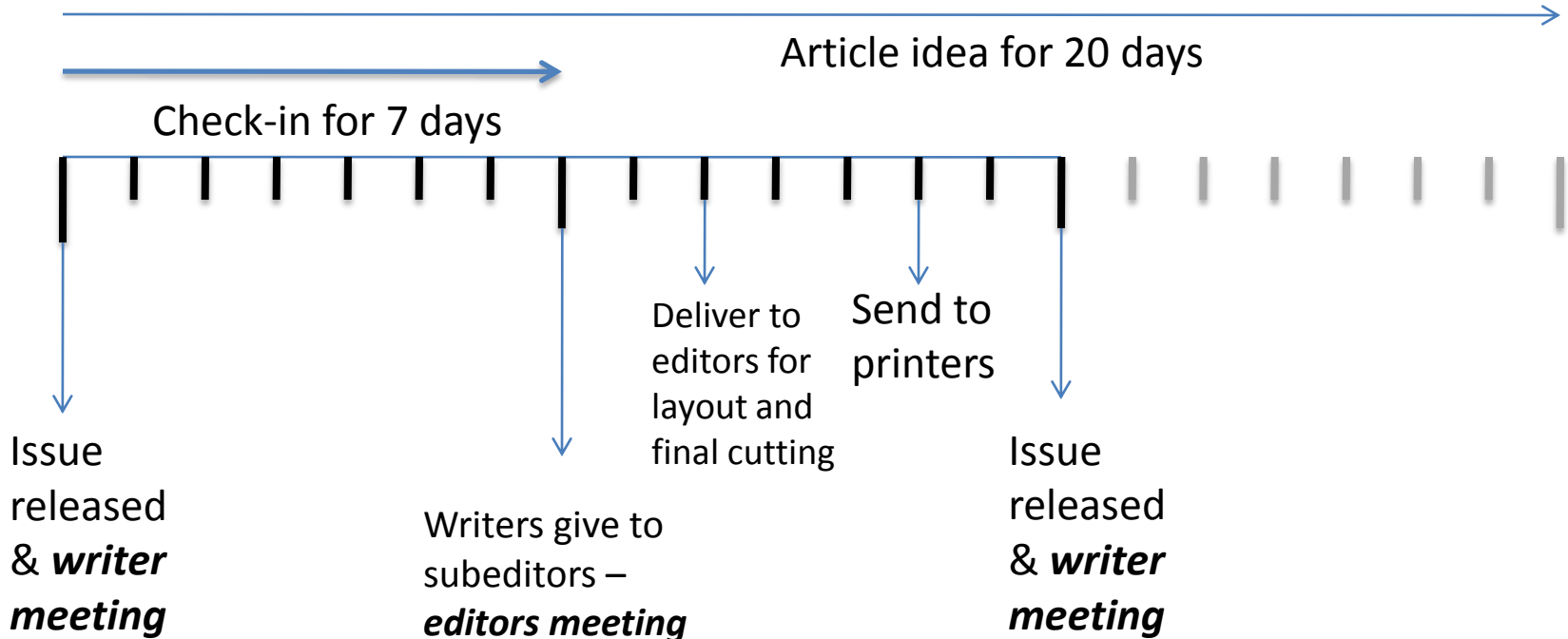

- **14 day cycle**, one meeting with editors and one with writers each fortnight
- Writers have two ideas going each meeting - one due in 20 days, the other in 7 days
- Subeditors get 2 days to edit and deliver content from writers
- Editors get 3 days to discuss with subeditors and produce layout and send to printer

- \$7.50/100 words standard rate
 - May be varied according to advertising income
 - Payment quarterly by cheque
 - Regular writers achieving \$200-300 per quarter in addition to recognised publishing experience and 14 issues of woroni to be proud of
